

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Skirennen

Golf Course, Leavenworth, WA

Saturday January 12th

10K Freestyle

Race Start 9:30AM

Mass start 2 x 5k lap

Forecast/Conditions: **Friday Night**...Chance of snow. Lows in the 20s.. **Saturday**...Chance of snow showers. Morning temperatures 28-32.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red / Yellow 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Hi Speed, and polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush. HelX Warm would make an excellent alternative to JetStream.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A medium or universal structure will best suit these conditions.

Check the Waxtip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork as the expense of durability.
