

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## **Methow Valley Pursuit**

Winthrop, WA, Chickadee Trailhead

Saturday January 19

15K Classic

Race Start 10AM

Individual Start

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night low of 21 with a chance of snow both Friday night and Saturday morning with a race time snow temperature expected of 23 degrees.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a thermopad. HelX Cold would make an excellent alternative to JetStream.

Gripwax: Roughen kick zone with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in TOKO base Green Binder. Cover with TOKO Carbon Gripwax Viola, or Red for more kick. See Toko bench prior to start.

Structure: A universal structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
