

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Methow Valley Pursuit

Winthrop, WA, Mazama Community Center Trailhead

Sunday January 20

30K Freestyle

Race Start 9AM for Pursuit Racers, 9:50 Citizens

Individual Start Based on Previous Day Times

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday night low of 15 with a 30 per cent chance of snow predicted. Race time snow temperature of 17 degrees expected.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a thermopad. HeIX Cold would make an excellent alternative to JetStream.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A universal or fine linear structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HeIX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
