

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Cabin Creek Exit #63, I-90, WA

Sunday January 27

30K Classic

Race Start 10AM

3x10K Laps

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday night lows in 20's snow likely.
Sunday highs near 30-32 with snow showers.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Yellow/HF Red, mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream HighSpeed, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a thermopad. HeIX Warm would make an excellent alternative to JetStream.

Gripwax: Roughen kick zone with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in TOKO base Green Binder. Cover with TOKO Carbon Gripwax Red. See Toko easel for current information.

Structure: A universal structure will best suit these conditions.

Check the Waxtip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HeIX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
