

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Nancy P's Classic

Mt Bachelor, OR

Saturday December 22

10K or 20K

Race Start 10AM

Mass Start, expect 80+ skiers

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night expect lows near 15F.
Saturday highs near 28F, with snow showers likely.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream HighSpeed, polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush. HeIX Cold would make an excellent alternative to JetStream. Both, require a final buff with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in Base wax Green. Cover with 2-3 layers of Carbon Gripwax Blue.

Structure: A fine linear stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HeIX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
