

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## Hanel Loop Race Series

Mt Hood, OR

Sunday February 10

10K Skate

Race Start 10AM

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday night low 27F, snow likely.  
Sunday high 33, snow likely.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by preparing base for HelX Warm, by polishing with the Yellow side of a dual pad, applying Helx Warm, allowing to dry, then polish with the white side of a dual pad.

Gripwax: Roughen kick zone with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in TOKO base Green Binder. Cover with TOKO Carbon Gripwax Viola.

Structure: A fine structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
