

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Cascade Crest

Mt Bachelor, OR

Saturday March 22

15K or 30K Freestyle

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night: Low 18 with a 20% chance of snow showers. Saturday: High, 36, partly cloudy

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a thermopad. A light cover with HelX Warm can make for faster skis.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A pass with the coarse-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool, (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
