

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Payette Lakes Ski Marathon

McCall, ID

Saturday, February 20

30K Classic (9 A.M.) or Skate (10 A.M.)

Forecast/Conditions: Low of 16 overnight Friday with a high of 33 on Saturday. Expect the snow to stay in the low to mid 20s. Snow will be partially transformed. This course is pretty much just one loop, so waxing colder than normal will be effective (hence the JS Blue).

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/HF Red mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Most likely the best wax will be to go with Carbon Klister Base Green and cover with the wax of the day. This is a race day decision to make though. Unfortunately, this year Toko will not have anyone on site to help with this decision. We will in the future of course.

Structure: A fine linear structure. One strong pass of the Toko Structurite with the Blue bit after applying the JetStream will work well. Follow this by rubbing the JetStream wax on top and polishing it for an optimal finish.

Racing - Service

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
