

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## 2009 CNGB Western Regional Championships

Rendezvous Ski Trails, West Yellowstone, MT

Saturday, Dec. 12

9 A.M. Zero, 10 A.M. Start

3 x 6K Relay

Mass Start

Multiple laps of a 2km loop

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low -4F with temperature at start 15 and an expected high of 24. Expect well-groomed, firm track conditions with cold older snow and some cold new snow mixed in. Mostly cloudy, chance of snow throughout the day.

Glidewax: Apply System 3 Blue, scrape and brush. Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/HF Red mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue and Red mixed 1:1, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Structure: A fine linear structure covered by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
