Mass Start

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low around 19 with gusty winds. Race day temperature at start in mid-20s, sunny and windy. Expect transformed machined snow.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/HF Red mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A fine to universal grind covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool before JetStream application will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a roto cork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
