Forecast/Conditions: Start temperature should be 10-15 degrees F with little to no new snow. Temperature will rise into low teens with 40 percent chance of snow during the race. There will be significant temperature variation between the start at 6311 feet and the high point of the race at 10,450 feet.

Snow conditions are generally firm but carveable. There will be some sections of very firm/icy snow. Sharp edges are recommended for maximum performance and safety.

Glidewax: Use LF/HF blue, for both ski bases and skins. If hot waxing skins, be very careful with iron temperature. If you have never waxed skins, it may be better to just rub it in to the nap of the skin.

Racing - Service

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue).
