Mass Start

One Lap

Forecast/Conditions: Race time temperature around 32. Overnight low 27. New snow with a 90 percent probability of precipitation. Predicted accumulations 3 to 7 inches during race.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Structure: A fine to medium stone grind. A fine or typical standard "factory grind," will suit these conditions. One pass with the Blue Structurite tool before JetStream application will work well, especially on worn bases.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue).
