Forecast/Conditions: Friday overnight low 11, partly cloudy. Saturday mostly sunny, start temperature mid-20s warming to high of 34. Expect old snow, compacted, transformed in places and turning sugary in places.

Glidewax: Apply mix of LF Moly/LF Blue 1:1, scrape and brush. Then apply HF Moly/HF Blue mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking Jetstream Blue, brush with a dedicated polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Structure: A fine linear structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue).
