

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## Junior National Qualifier #1

Rendezvous Trails, West Yellowstone, WY

Sunday, January 15

9 A.M.

10K/5K/3K/1K Classic Technique

Interval start

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low 6F, sunny Sunday with a high of 30. Temperature at morning start anticipated in upper teens to low 20s, expect packed powder mixed with transformed snow.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/HF Red mix 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 4-5 layers of Nordic GripWax Blue, corking between layers.

Structure: A fine linear structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
