

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## Utah Winter Games

Soldier Hollow, Heber City, UT

Saturday January 12

10K Skate

Race Start 11AM

2 laps, interval start

Forecast/Conditions: Snow will be falling throughout the week. Friday night low 11F and high Saturday 32F. Chance of light snow. College race will be held in the am (skate), so things should be pretty set up despite the new snow. Although the air will be around freezing, it is always a good thing to wax a bit cold at Soldier Hollow.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/HF Red, mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, buff with a thermopad. HelX Cold would make an excellent alternative to JetStream.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A fine structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
