

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Teton Ridge Classic

Teton Ridge Ranch, 10m N.E. of Driggs, ID

Saturday January 12

5, 14, or 28K Classic

Race Start 10AM

Mass Start

Forecast/Conditions: Conditions: Lots of cold fresh powder snow. Forecast: Friday night low of 12F, with 20% chance of snow. Saturday high of 28F, mostly cloudy and 20% chance of snow showers.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, buff with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in TOKO base Green binder. Cover with 2 thin layers of TOKO Carbon Gripwax Blue, and a top layer of Carbon White. If warmer, cover Viola with Blue

Structure: A fine universal structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (Helix, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
