

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## **Billy Goat Loppet**

Billy's Bridge Trailhead, Harriman Trail, Ketchum, ID

Saturday January 26

10K Freestyle

Race Start 11AM, Registration from 9:30-10:30

Forecast/Conditions: Friday Night: A 20 percent chance of snow. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 7. Wind chill values between -8 and zero. South southwest wind between 8 and 11 mph. Saturday: A 40 percent chance of snow. Cloudy, with a high near 37. Wind chill values between -8 and 2. South southwest wind between 11 and 16 mph, with gusts as high as 24 mph.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A fine structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (Helix, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
