

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Wasatch Citizens Series

White Pine Nordic Center, Park City, UT

Saturday January 6

15K Skate

Race Start 10AM

Multi-lap, Mass Start

Forecast/Conditions: **Friday Night:** Snow likely, mainly after 11pm. Cloudy, with a low around 25. Windy. Chance of precipitation is 60%. **Saturday:** Periods of snow. High near 32. Winds could gust as high as 44 mph. Chance of precipitation is 100% Possibly heavy wet snow with soft track. Three laps around 5 km loop with up to 300 skiers.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream HighSpeed, polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, buff with a thermopad. HelX Warm would make an excellent alternative to JetStream.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A warm universal structure, or one pass with coarse linear TOKO Structurerite (if raining) on a soft flexing ski will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
