

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

White Pine Relay

White Pine Touring, Park City, UT

Saturday December 15

3X5KM Relay

Race Start 10AM

Mass Start, 1st lap Classic, 2nd and 3rd Skate

Forecast/Conditions: Low 3F overnight, high of 30F Sat with a 40% chance of snow. With little chance of the sun coming out, the snow will stay cold.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly/LF Blue, mixed 1:1, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Followed by rotocorking JetStream Moly, polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finishing with a polish from a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 180 Grit sandpaper, and iron in TOKO Base Green Binder. Cover with TOKO Carbon Grip Blue, finish application by corking well.

Structure: A fine/smooth stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (Helix, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
