

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Wasatch Citizens Series

Soldier Hollow, Heber Valley, UT

Saturday December 8

5/10K Classic (1 or 2, 5km laps)

Race Start 10AM

Forecast/Conditions: Low of 23 Friday night
High of 36 Saturday. High humidity and perhaps some new falling snow that will glaze in the tracks.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush. Follow by applying HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream HighSpeed, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polishing with a thermopad..

Gripwax: Sand base with 180 grit sand paper, and iron in Basewax Green. Will more than likely be Carbon Grip Red or Yellow. See TOKO easel at race site for most current information.

Structure: A medium/universal stonegrind, or two passes with the course linear Structurite wheel (before applying JetStream HS) will best suit these conditions.

Racing - Service

Check the Waxtip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelIX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
