

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Marco's Classic Cup

McDonald Pass, Helena, MT

Saturday February 16

12K Classic

Race Start 11AM

Interval Start

Forecast/Conditions: **Friday Night:** A 20 percent chance of snow showers after 11pm. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 28. West southwest wind between 6 and 13 mph. **Saturday:** Mostly sunny, with a high near 40. West wind between 10 and 17 mph, with gusts as high as 23 mph

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/HF Yellow, mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen kick zone with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in TOKO base Green Klister Binder. See onsite recommendation.

Structure: A fine structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
