1K, 2K, 5K kids and juniors, 9K and 19K adults

Race Start 10AM kids and juniors, 11AM adults

Freestyle

Forecast/Conditions: **Friday Night:** A 40 percent chance of snow, mainly after 11pm. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 16. West southwest wind 5 to 8 mph increasing to between 14 and 17 mph. Winds could gust as high as 22 mph. **Saturday:** Partly sunny, with a high near 38. West wind between 8 and 17 mph, with gusts as high as 23 mph.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A fine structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (Helix, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
