

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## World Masters Championships

Ponderosa State Park, McCall, I D

Thursday 6, March

15-45k Classic

Start times from 9am

Forecast/Conditions: Low of 4F Wednesday night and a high of 36F Thursday. Expect cold snow in the shade all day with warming tracks in the sun. The tracks will glaze a lot in the sunny areas.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush. M10-12 and F10-12 Classic skiers apply HF Blue/Red mix. All others apply HF Red. After scraping and brushing, apply JetStream High Speed. Brush out with Nylon Polishing Brush and brush out with Thermo Pad.

Gripwax: Sand kick zone with 180 grit sandpaper. Iron in Carbon Basewax Green, smooth and let cool. Apply repeated layers of Carbon Basewax Green until there is an extremely thick layer applied pretty short over a pair of hard track skis (not too soft or they will drag). The Green should be so thick, you should easily be able to see the color in it from 10 feet away.

Structure: 4 passes with coarse linear Structurite

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork as the expense of durability.
